Reviewers may request additional information only if they believe the proposal will be funded. After additional information is received, a recommendation for funding will be determined. **Letters of support are not required.**

Recommendation for Funding

- 1. Approval for amount requested
- 2. Approval for reduced amount
- 3. Disapprove

The **Grant Award** may be up to \$3,000.

Reporting Requirement

A final report will be due 2 months after the completion of the project, including a final budget and an accounting of the funds. Should the grant project last more than 1 year, an annual progress report must be submitted. At the completion of the project any remaining funds must be returned to the National Center for Dental Hygiene Research & Practice, Inc.
